Consultation Strategy

Consultation is a key activity for the Town Council, including in working with others in following the Neighbourhood Plan preparation process as outlined in the Localism Act (2011).

In its work with others to prepare a Bracknell Neighbourhood Plan, the Council is committed to inclusive and open participation by the local community in order to develop the most representative plan possible.

It is intended this will then be demonstrated when our Plan is submitted for independent review to prove that the Plan is founded on a local evidence base and is therefore representative of the local community as far as this is possible.

This is why it is necessary to record and document the events that are being run to encourage the community to provide feedback or participate in the Plan.

The consultation activity will be to both to hold both specific Neighbourhood Plan events and also to make use of other community events that are happening in Bracknell throughout the period of preparing the Plan.
