INFORMATION FOR PARK USERS AND RESIDENTS

Bracknell Town Council are due to commence works at Great Hollands Recreation Ground. The new pavilion will replace the existing pavilion and in doing so update the facilities to create a better user experience for recreational and leisure activities. The main aim of the new pavilion is to provide updated facilities for the users of the pavilion and outdoor space. The children's play area will also be improved along with an accessible water feature.

Due to the Great Hollands pavilion rebuild, there will be limited facilities at this site whilst the construction phase is being carried out. We ask that all park users are vigilant of the work vehicles accessing the site during this time.
