

**Bracknell Town Council** is the largest Parish within the Unitary Authority of Bracknell Forest. It provides services to over half the population of the Borough (54,000) located within 12 Wards making up the central area of the Borough.

The Town Council is responsible for over 250 acres of recreational and leisure space including 34 children's plays areas. It manages extensive sports facilities including football and rugby pitches, a floodlit synthetic pitch, 2 floodlit ball courts, tennis, basketball, crazy golf, a skate park etc. Pavilions in a number of the parks provide coffee shop facilities and halls for hire. A full description of the facilities and services provided by Bracknell Town Council can be found on the Council's website.



Other responsibilities include management of the Council's Environment Warden, seven allotment sites, various bus shelters, seats, bins and the Larges Lane Cemetery. The Town Council also coordinates Bracknell's entry in Britain in Bloom (we won Gold in 2013 and Silver Gilt in 2014).



Bracknell Town is twinned with Leverkusen in Germany and the Town Council provides support to Bracknell Twinning Association as well as providing grants to other local organisations.
